We operate five strategically located farms across Egypt, each selected for optimal soil and climate conditions:


- El-Salhia Fram ( Ismalia Governorate).

**Inspection** – Continuous monitoring of raw and finished goods



**Labeling compliance** (nutrition, allergens, traceability)







Green Beans



**Green Beans** are usually grown in cool weather, with planting from late fall to early winter.

### Varieties:

- Sybaris
- Moraleda
- Paulista

### Packages:

- Loose 5 Kg
- Loose 6 Kg
- Pre-packed 500g
- Pre-packed 400g











Green Peas

**Peas** are primarily a cool-season crop, typically planted in winter to early spring and harvested about 60–70 days after planting.

### Varieties:

1. Snow Peas (Mange tout)
2. Sugar Snap Peas
3. Garden Peas
4. Snow Wind
5. Sweet Horizon
6. Snow Max










Spring Onions



**Spring Onions** usually planted from July to January, and harvested 60–90 days after planting, which means harvest can occur from October to March

**Variety:**

- Photon
- Giza Large

- Bunched (8x - 10x - 14x) (120g – 140g)















Strawberries

Strawberries are usually planted in late summer to early fall (August to October), with the ideal growing conditions being moderate temperatures.

Proper irrigation and pest management are the keys to our successful crop.






Table Grapes


